Meeting report - Ambassador Money Request

The Polish Conferences in Hydrobiology aim to connect researches working on all aspect of aquatic microbiology: freshwater and marine ecology, waste water treatment microbiology, and biotechnology. The 9th edition was held in Hotel Omega in Olsztyn. The conference attracted 57 participants: 21 men and 36 women. 33 oral presentation and 24 posters were submitted in 8 research topics:

- Microorganisms in inland, ground and marine waters
- Microorganisms in environmental engineering
- Bacteriological and sanitary aspects of waste water treatment
- Transport of pathogenic microorganisms in aquatic environments
- Biological contamination in aquatic systems
- Water biosafety and bioremediation
- Diagnostics of aquatic microorganisms
- Industrial microbiology and microbial biotechnology.

The support from ISME (500 EUR) was used to fund best poster awards. They went to:

1. Kamil Hamal, Magdalena Domańska and Janusz Łomotowski from Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences, poster title: „Investigation of sediment from artificial bacterial culture BETA-OAB”;
2. Agata Siedlecka and Katarzyna Piekarska from Technical University in Wrocław, poster title: „Preliminary analysis of factors determining resistance in water from Wrocław water supply network”
3. Jacek Potorski and Piotr Niewiadomski from University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn, poster title „Quantitative and qualitative effect of addition of flour from *Amaranthus* spp. on microbial composition of fodders stored at different temperatures”.

In the frame of the ISME support, I gave 15 minutes presentation about the ISME on the first day of the conference. The ISME logo was placed on the conference webpage (<http://www.hydromicro.pl/>) and on the conference materials.
