Profile of Attendance

At ISME16, which took place in Montreal, Canada, in 2016, nearly half of the delegates came from countries in North and Latin America (48%). 30% came from European countries, 21% from countries in Asia and Oceania, 1% from African countries.

The majority of delegates are researchers and staff connected to fields of microbial ecology from Universities and Research Institutes, both governmental and private. At ISME16, 37% of the delegates were Scientists and Senior Scientists, 20% were Postdocs, 36% PhD Students, and 7% were Bachelor and Master Students.
