# **Profile of Attendance**

At ISME16, which took place in Montreal, Canada, in 2016, nearly half of the delegates came from countries in North and Latin America (48%). 30% came from European countries, 21% from countries in Asia and Oceania, 1% from African countries.

The majority of delegates are researchers and staff connected to fields of microbial ecology from Universities and Research Institutes, both governmental and private.
